Re: Pension Legislation

Dear Fellow Members,

As the House and Senate members are returning from recess, they need to hear from you. The Pension Legislation has been bottled up in conference for several weeks. It is important to reiterate that it is essential that the Senate language providing for American Airlines and others with on-going employee pension plans be included in the final bill coming out of conference. Section 403 of the Senate bill S1783 contains this language. Your Senators and Representatives need to hear this message from you!

You are urged to go to twuatd.org and select the **Legislative Action Center**. This will enable you to contact your Senators and Representatives, and help compose the text of a message to them.

Timing is critical. I urge you to take time to phone your Representative and Senators. You are encourage you to use this format:

Call as soon as possible and when you do share the following in your own words:

1. I am an employee/retiree of American Airlines.
2. Encourage your Senator/Representative to contact their colleagues working on the pension reform bill to ensure that the airline provision of the Senate bill be included in the final version coming out of conference.
3. This is of the highest urgency to me personally, my fellow members, and my company.
4. American Airlines continues to meet the commitments made to its employees by prudently maintaining the highest level of pension funding in the industry.
5. Please help protect the retirements of American's employees by contacting your colleagues working on the pension reform today.
