Re: ATD Staffing 2007 Changes

Dear Brother Yingst:

Over the last few weeks we have discussed various staffing needs for the Air Transport Division. Based on your pending hip surgery and extended recovery period, it has become more problematic. I know there is an immediate need to begin preparations for the upcoming American Airlines contract negotiations this year. As you reported at our last International Executive Council and Board meeting, this year and next year the Air Transport Division will have a number of open contracts: both of our Southwest agreements, American Eagle as well as our service contracts. I have also reviewed our aggressive agenda with our Organizing Director that will, no doubt, impact our Air Transport Division staff assignments.

Therefore, I concur with your request for assistance and I will assign our International Vice President Dennis Burchette to the Air Transport Division effective April 2, 2007. Dennis will report directly to the Air Transport Division Director with his principle responsibility to assist the Air Transport Division and American Airlines Presidents' Council with American Airlines negotiation preparations and other duties assigned.

As we previously discussed, we will also implement the following changes:

Effective March 5, 2007, Ed Hill, President, TWU Local 525, will assume your duties and responsibilities over our service contracts and assist with Local 500. He will, however continue as President of Local 525.


Effective April 2, 2007, I have assigned Joe Gordon, International Representative, to assume your duties as Acting Director of the Air Transport Division during your absence. To the extent possible, and your availability, he will confer and keep you apprised of any major changes within the Air Transport Division.

Effective April 2, 2007, at the request of Legislative Director Roger Tauss, I have assigned Alex Garcia, President, TWU Local 568 (while remaining as President of the Local) to be working on some special projects for our Legislative and Political Office in Washington, DC and he will report directly to Director Roger Tauss and International Representative Portia Reddick White.

I hope these changes will assist the Air Transport Division in meeting the challenges ahead. I would also like to wish you a speedy recovery from your upcoming surgery.
