Dear Brothers:

As you are probably aware, the Allied Pilots Association (APA) is planning a Rally at APA headquarters, and a subsequent march, on Wednesday, April 18, 2007. The TWU understands the theme of the APA National Rally to be "Pilot Unity Pays" or "PUP."

The TWU ATD received an update regarding the march on April 5, 2007. The communication encourages all AA employees to attend in uniform and participate in the march to AMR headquarters from 1215 – 1315; appropriate signage will be provided. Additionally, the APA intends to host a barbeque at the headquarters immediately following the march. The rally itself is Pilot centric. Guest speakers are scheduled to address the APA's Pilots from 1100 to approximately 12-1215.

To be clear, this event was never planned as a collaborative tri-party effort. However, with the exception of issues germane to our Pilots, the TWU, APA, and APFA stand solidly aligned in opposition to the Performance Share Plan.
