Dear Brothers:

I was officially notified by Local 563 that a Special Membership Meeting was held on May 30, 2007 for all Title V Stock Clerks.

The notice certified that a majority vote supported the motion that was made to approve "separate negotiation" for all Title V Stock Clerks in the American Airlines System.

As a result of the vote in the affirmative, and in accordance with Section IV, Paragraph E (1) of the TWU/AA Presidents Council By-Laws, all TWU/AA Locals representing Title V Stock Clerks are required to schedule a "special membership" vote within sixty (60) days to decide the issue.

Please be advised that it is imperative that you review the requirements as outlined in Section IV, Paragraph E, 1-4 of the TWU/AA Presidents Council By-Laws for guidance.

Once the review has been concluded, you are further advised to take the appropriate steps so that all Title V Stock Clerks throughout the American Airlines System will have the opportunity to cast their vote either FOR or AGAINST the motion for separate negotiations.

Your immediate attention to this extremely important matter is imperative!

Please report the final results of the mail ballot vote to the ATD office as outlined in Section IV, E-3 of the TWU/AA Presidents Council By-Laws. The timeline for this vote is August 6, 2007 5:00 EST. Please have your ballots counted and the results faxed to the ATD office no later than this date and time.

In accordance with Paragraph IV, Section E of the American Airlines System Presidents Council Bylaws, the TWU American Airlines System Coordinator has requested that the Stores contract group be allowed to decide the issue of Joint vs. Separate bargaining.
