Pursuant to a signed letter agreement dated July 6, 2007 with Mark Hnat, Recording Secretary of the Transport Workers Union of America, AFL-CIO, Local 562, hereinafter referred to as "Local 562," the American Arbitration Association, hereinafter referred to as the "Administrator," agreed to conduct a Special Negotiations Election.

Eighty seven (87) ballot packets were mailed to eligible voters on Monday, July 16, 2007 as follows:


The counting of ballots took place at the offices of the Administrator, 1633 Broadway,
